Description: Comic page (1).

Entry Points: Episode guide page, via "Previous", "Next", "First" and "Last" navigation buttons, direct link.

Notes

- 1 **Title tag.** Title tag for Comic pages should follow this template: <comic series name> - <name of comic> .  
  
Example:  
  
Flintlocke's Guide to Azeroth - Second Annual Holiday Special
- 2 **Comic Series short description.** Editorial should provide a short description with each Comic to be included in a Meta Description Tag.
- 3 **Web Comic page dimensions.** Web Comic is designed for standard 1024 screen width. Actual page is 978 pixels in width.
- 4 **Comic Series Graphic Header image.** Graphic image featuring series name.
- 5 **Navigation - Beginning.** Navigation button which is linked to the first item in the Comic Series. If current comic is the first Comic in the Series, the button is displayed grayed out (inactive.)  
  
**NOTE TO DEVELOPERS:** When coding the template, allow for custom buttons graphics for each comic series. If a comic series does not have custom navigation buttons, that series should use the default button design.
- 6 **Navigation - Previous.** Links to Comic published immediately prior to current Comic. If current Comic is the first Comic in the Series, the button is displayed grayed out (inactive.)
- 7 **Navigation - Next.** Links to Next Comic in Series. If the current Comic is the latest, button is grayed out (inactive.)
- 8 **Navigation - Latest.** Links to most recent Comic in Series. If the current comic is the Latest, button is grayed out (inactive.)
- 9 **Episode Title.** Title of displayed Episode. The header needs to include the Episode name and be placed within an H1 (<h1> </h1>) tag.
- 10 **Episode Part.** If the Comic is part of a multi-part episode, display the part number.
- 11 **Byline and Publication Date.** If the Comic has a byline, display the byline as a link to "http://feedback.gamespy.com followed by a pipe symbol and the pub date. If no byline, just display pub date.
- 12 **Web Comic Panels.** Images for the Web Comic. Images will be posted uploaded through NIB.

Entry Points: Episode guide page, via "Previous", "Next", "First" and "Last" navigation buttons, direct link.

Notes

- 1 **Med Rect Ad.** 300px width by 250px height.
- 2 **Link to Fargo's Blog.** NOT NECESSARY FOOR INITIAL RELEASE. Should be inserted when Blogs become available on GameSpy.
- 3 **In the Forums.** Highest-rated quote from the previous day (as with user submission quotes on IGN hub pages.) Display box is fixed size (to be determined by visual designer.)
- 4 **In the Forums – Forum icon.** Display the icon which appears on the GameSpy Forums. (Requires visual design.)
- 5 **In the Forums – Quote.** Variable-height container which displays an editorially-slotted Forum quote and icon image from Forums. Anchor links determined by editorial. Container may hold other data at editorial's discretion.
- 6 **In the Forums – Links.** Each quote will be accompanied by two links. 1) Display number of replies to forum post linked to originating thread for quote on GameSpy Forums. 2) Display text reading "Reply to This" linked to GameSpy Forums post reply form for the displayed post.
- 7 **Hot Forum Topics.** Variable-height container which displays the 5 most replied-to postings for the previous 24 hours. In case of a tie (or no postings have replies), default to display by latest publication date.
- 8 **Hot Forum Topics – Thread Topic.** Display the entire thread topic string for the Hot Topic, allowing string to break automatically (and increasing height of container, if necessary.)
- 9 **Hot Forum Topics – Posting time stamp and posting user.** Display time stamp of post using identical logic as employed "Last Post" column of "My Favorite Boards" section on http://forums.gamespy.com. Display posting user's name (without user styles) linked to user's Profile page (http://forums.gamespy.com/UserPages/Profile.aspx?user=[user name]).
- 10 **Right column flexibility.** Design for right column editorial flexibility. Editorial may want to insert graphics in this column from time to time to promote Previews, etc.

**Entry Points:** Episode guide page, via "Previous", "Next", "First" and "Last" navigation buttons, direct link.

Notes

- 1 **Email a Friend and Bookmark.** Include standard user notification and bookmarking feature as found on GameSpy.com.
- 2 **Comments.** Display standard article comments container utilizing same functions and parameters as IGN article comments. Comments are identical to posts on GameSpy Forums thread for Comic. Comments are specific to comic displayed on page.
- 3 **Comments – Moderator link.** For Moderators and above, display moderation link.
- 4 **Comments – View All link.** Display standard article View All link, linked to View All page.
- 5 **Navigation.** Replicate navigation bar from top of page.
- 6 **Image of character's face.** Display an image of character's face as provided by GameSpy editorial. Face will be linked to sound file which may open a new browser window to play (based on viewer's MIME settings.) The functionality replicates current functionality on GameSpy Comics.
- 7 **About.** Link takes viewer to About page for Comic Series.
- 8 **Episode Guide link.** Links to Episode Guide page.
- 9 **Latest [comic] box.** Links to latest comics – identical to current comics page.
- 10 **More WoW Coverage.** Variable-height container which displays editorially-slotted include, similar to "GameSpy News" section found on <http://forums.gamespy.com>. If no content is slotted, do not display container.

**Entry Points:** "View All Comments" link in Comments section of Comic page, direct link.

Notes

- 1 **Web Comic page dimensions.** Web Comic is designed for standard 1024 screen width. Actual page is 978 pixels in width.
- 2 **Comic Series Graphic Header image.** Graphic image featuring Series name.
- 3 **Navigation.** Navigation buttons will allow users to navigate the "View All Comments" pages a comic at a time. The design should be visually distinct from the navigation of the actual comic pages to avoid confusion about where the destination of each link.
- 4 **Navigation – Episode Guide.** Links to Episode Guide page.
- 5 **Navigation – Previous Comic.** Links to "View All Comments" page for previous Comic.
- 6 **Navigation – Next Comic.** Links to "View All Comments" page for next Comic in Series. If the currently viewed is the latest, button is grayed out (inactive.)
- 7 **Episode Title and Part number (if applicable.)** Title and part number of Comic that the comments reference.
- 8 **Byline.** If the Comic has a byline, display the byline as a link to "http://feedback.gamespy.com". Display publication date of Comic separated from byline by pipe symbol. If no byline, just display pub date.
- 9 **Comic first panel.** IF POSSIBLE, display the first panel of the Comic. Analogous to the snippet on IGN article comments.
- 10 **All Comments.** Display all comments for Comic using functionality and UI as found on "View All Comments" for IGN Article pages including pagination and input form.
- 11 **Navigation.** Replicate navigation found at top of page at the end of the comments section.
- 12 **Navigation.** For Web Comics, return link should read "Back to Comic".
- 13 **Right Column.** Right column replicates right column found on Comic pages.

Notes

**1 Title tag.** Title tag for Episode Guide pages should follow this template: GameSpy Comics - <comic series name> .

Example:

GameSpy Comics - Flintlocke's Guide to Azeroth

**2 Meta Description Tag.** Duplicate the first 200 characters of the Comic short description found further down the page (4) into a Meta Description Tag for this page.

**3 Header, subheader, byline, pub date and Series description.** Same as with existing Comic. The header needs to include the Comic Series name and be placed within an H1 (<h1> </h1>) tag.

**4 Comic Series short description.** Short description of comic as on current version. First 200 characters used in meta tag (2).

**5 Latest Comic.** Display the first panel or a thumbnail to the latest comic linked to Comic page. Display name of Comic also linked to Comic page.

**6 Episodes.** List of Episodes in Series is similar to existing Guide with text area is wider to accommodate wider column width. For episodes divided into Parts, list individual Parts linked to appropriate page in manner shown.

**7 Bookmarks and Latest Comic links.** Same as on Comic Page (3) and as on existing Episode Guide.

**8 Right Column.** Right column replicates right column found on Comic pages.
